### **Architect**

Annual salary range: \$44,000 – \$120,000

Description: Plan and design structures, such as private residences, office buildings, theaters, factories, and other structural property.

### **Architectural & Civil Drafters**

Annual salary range: \$31,000 - \$73,000

Description: Prepare detailed drawings of architectural and structural features of buildings or drawings and topographical relief maps used in civil engineering projects, such as highways, bridges, and public works. Use knowledge of building materials, engineering practices, and mathematics to complete drawings.

### **Architectural Manager**

Annual salary range: \$78,000 - \$186,000

Description: Plan, direct, or coordinate activities in architecture or research and development in architecture.

### **Landscape Architect**

Annual salary range: \$37,000 - \$99,000

Description: Plan and design land areas for projects such as parks and other recreational facilities, airports, highways, hospitals, schools, land subdivisions, and commercial, industrial, and residential sites.

### **Interior Designer**

Annual salary range: \$31,000 - \$66,000

Description: An interior designer is someone who plans, researches, coordinates, and manages such projects. Interior design is a multifaceted profession that includes conceptual development, space



planning, site inspections, programming, research, communicating with the stakeholders of a project, construction management, and execution of the design.
